

## COMPLETION/GRADUATION RATE (STUDENTS RIGHT TO KNOW)

Full-Year Adjusted Cohort (September 1, 2013 - August 31, 2014) of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students

Overall Graduation Rate – The rate required for disclosure and reporting purposes under Student Right-to-Know Act. The following completion/graduation rates are based upon a limited cohort of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate seeking undergraduate students who entered Gnomon between September 1, 2013 - August 31, 2014, as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The rate is calculated as the total number of completers/graduates within 150% of normal time divided by the total number of students in the full year adjusted cohort.
