Overall Graduation Rate – The rate required for disclosure and reporting purposes under Student Right-to-Know Act. The following completion/graduation rates are based upon a limited cohort of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered Gnomon in the Fall quarter of 2013, as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The rate is calculated as the total number of completers/graduates within 150% of normal time divided by the total number of students in the Fall cohort.
